I will learn how to graduate horizontal and vertical strokes using watercolours.

I can make felt fish from wool using carding, twisting, rubbing and rolling.



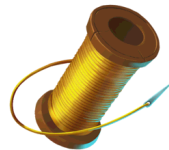
I can design, make and evaluate a clay coil pot.
