

South End Junior School staff car park.

Both SEJ and SEI have a combined role of 630 pupils and 108 staff.

The schools share a car park with 64 spaces including 2 designated extra wide bays for disabled parking. Entry and exit points are barrier controlled. There are also 2 separate pedestrian/cyclist entrances to the site.

Our priority is to ensure all children are safe whilst entering and leaving the school site. We will mitigate any risks of injury to children whilst accessing or leaving the site.

Parents/carers are encouraged to walk their child(ren) to school.

Alternatively, parents/carers can park on the public highway outside the school (highway rules apply). Any parent/carer parking on the public highway is asked to do so safely, in accordance with the highway Code and with due consideration for residents (don't block driveways) and pedestrians.

Parents and carers are reminded that they are responsible for their children in the car park and they should be closely supervised at all times.

Permitted Access to the Staff Car Park.

- Any child with a permanent or temporary physical impairment.
- Any child with a blue badge
- Emergency services.
- Parents/carers to collect an unwell child between 9.30-2.30pm
- School deliveries out of peak times
- Professionals working with children

Temporary access may be permitted for emergencies, and on a case-by-case basis, outside of the school start and finish times. This is to ensure minimal risk where there is a higher pedestrian level.

Conditions.

- Please be sensible and considerate in your use of the car park.
- Park in designated bays or as directed by the site manager, obeying direction and speed signs.
- If unauthorised access to the car park has been gained inappropriately (e.g. tailgating), you will be instructed not to come on the site again, and further action could be taken.
- The schools accept no liability for damage caused to a vehicle at any time whilst in the school car park.

There will be no access for parents/carers to collect for appointments or for parent volunteers.
